INTRODUCTION

The National Guard Personnel, Air Force appropriation provides the required funding to assure accomplishment of the Air National Guard mission; and to provide trained units to selectively augment the active Air Force. The FY 1999 Budget Estimate is based on an average strength of 107,499 personnel who will be assigned to 88 ANG flying and 235 mission support units. In addition to annual 15-day tours and 48 drill periods, tours of active duty will provide training for selected ANG personnel. Included in the above average strengths are 10,839 full time active duty Guard personnel. Our budget also reflects a reimbursable program to support the Foreign Military Sales program of F-16 training and the National Science Foundation Antarctic mission transferred from the Navy. Reimbursable average strengths are 812 in FY 1999.

The \$1,376.1 million budget request for FY 1999 includes price growth of \$ 33.9 million and minimal program growth of \$7.5 million. Additionally, we anticipate increased unit conversion costs due to QDR mission changes. The FY 1999 program reflects the conversion of four F-16 Air Defense units to general purpose F-16s, the conversion of one general purpose F-16 unit to C-130s, and the conversion of one F-16 training unit to F-15 training in compliance with the Quadrennial Defense Review. Other force structure changes eliminate 700 civil engineering positions by the end of FY 1999.

This budget request represents the minimal level of funding required to accomplish the Air National Guard share of the National Defense mission. With the resources requested, the ANG will provide 100 percent of the Air Defense mission, 49 percent of tactical airlift, 40 percent of air refueling capability and 36 percent of all Air Force fighters. Further the ANG will provide significant non-flying support capability in areas such as combat communications and civil emergency support. The Air National Guard serves proudly and validates the credibility of our training program. As the total force is restructured, the ANG continues to accept new and increased national defense challenges in the most cost-effective manner.

ECONOMIC ASSUMPTIONS

National Guard Personnel, Air Force

The following are the economic assumptions employed in pricing the approved programs. Social Security costs are based on the percentage rate set by law on a member's salary for a calendar year. P.L. 98-21, "Social Security Amendment of 1983 " dated 20 April 1983 established the tax rate while the maximum taxable income is determined by the Social Security Administration. The Old Age, Survivor, and Disability Insurance (OASDI) rate is 6.2% and the Hospital Insurance (HI) is 1.45%. There is no wage cap on the 1.45 percent medical contribution. The Government's contribution is based on the percentage rate set by law on member's salary for a calendar year. The National Defense Authorization Act of 1998 established a new basic housing allowance (BAH) benefit that combines the basic allowance for quarters (BAQ) and variable housing allowance (VHA). Rate protection still applies to all housing allowances.

PART I - PURPOSE AND SCOPE

This budget activity provides for pay and allowances, retired pay accrual, clothing, subsistence and travel for Air National Guard officers and enlisted personnel assigned in Pay Group A. These personnel are authorized 15 days paid annual training and 48 paid inactive duty drill periods each fiscal year, additional flying training periods for personnel on flying status, and training period preparation assemblies for traditional Guardsmen with trainer responsibilities.

Program requirements are based on average strength and training participation rates for each fiscal year. The dollar rates used for pricing the program requirements are based on actual experience and reflect the applicable approved economic assumptions identified on page 2.2.

Our budget request increases for approved price growth projections. The C-130 force is funded in FY 1998 and 1999. Increased participation by traditional Guard personnel resulted in an internal reprogramming of funds from an AGR under-execution in FY 1997. This reprogramming was carried forward into FY 1998 and FY 1999. An estimated \$7.5 million funds the new travel entitlement approved in late FY 1997

PART II - JUSTIFICATION OF FUNDS REQUESTED

All individuals enlisting, re-enlisting, or extending for not less than six years in the Selected Reserve after 1 July, 1985, except those who have received a commission from a service academy or completed an ROTC scholarship program, are eligible to receive educational assistance unless they are entitled for assistance under Chapter 30 of Title 38 U.S.C. The individuals must also meet initial training and high school diploma or equivalency requirements. Cost estimates are actuarially based and reflect eligibility estimates adjusted by an estimate of ultimate benefit utilization and partially offset by an estimate of interest earned on investments of the Education Benefits Fund. The program will provide funds adequate to allow for one of three levels of assistance. These levels are \$140.00 per month for full-time educational pursuit, \$105.00 for three quarter time pursuit and \$70.00 for half time pursuit. The maximum total benefit that can be paid is \$5,040.00. The following table displays the actuarially based estimates and the per capita dollar rate for each fiscal year:
